Requested Action

The following resolution is presented for RRTPO review and approval:

RESOLVED, that the Richmond Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RRTPO) hereby adopts the *FY 2018 – FY 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* and the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process Self-Certification Statement as presented.

MPO Self-Certification Statement

Federal regulations require that concurrent with submission of the TIP, the state and the MPO are required to certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is being carried out in accordance with all applicable requirements.

These requirements include:

- MPO Continuing, Cooperatives and Comprehensive (3C) Process
- Air Quality Conformity
- Title VI, Environmental Justice, and Non-Discrimination

What is the TIP?

- Priority List of Projects Spanning at Least 4 Years
- Prepared in Cooperation with State and Public Transit Operator(s)
- The TIP is a Planned Obligations Document
- The TIP informs the Statewide TIP (STIP)
- Describes Projects
 - Must include regionally significant projects regardless of funding
 - May include non-federally funded projects
 - Must include federally funded projects
- Fiscally-Constrained
- Consistent with *plan2040*



TIP Development Schedule

August 2016

- FY18 – FY21 TIP development begins

October 2016

- **ACTION**: TPO approved of TIP Development Schedule – October 6, 2017

February 2017

- **ACTION**: TPO approval of opening public comment period – February 2, 2017

March 2017

- PUBLIC REVIEW MEETING – March 16, 2017
- Public Review Period Closed - March 24, 2017

April 2017

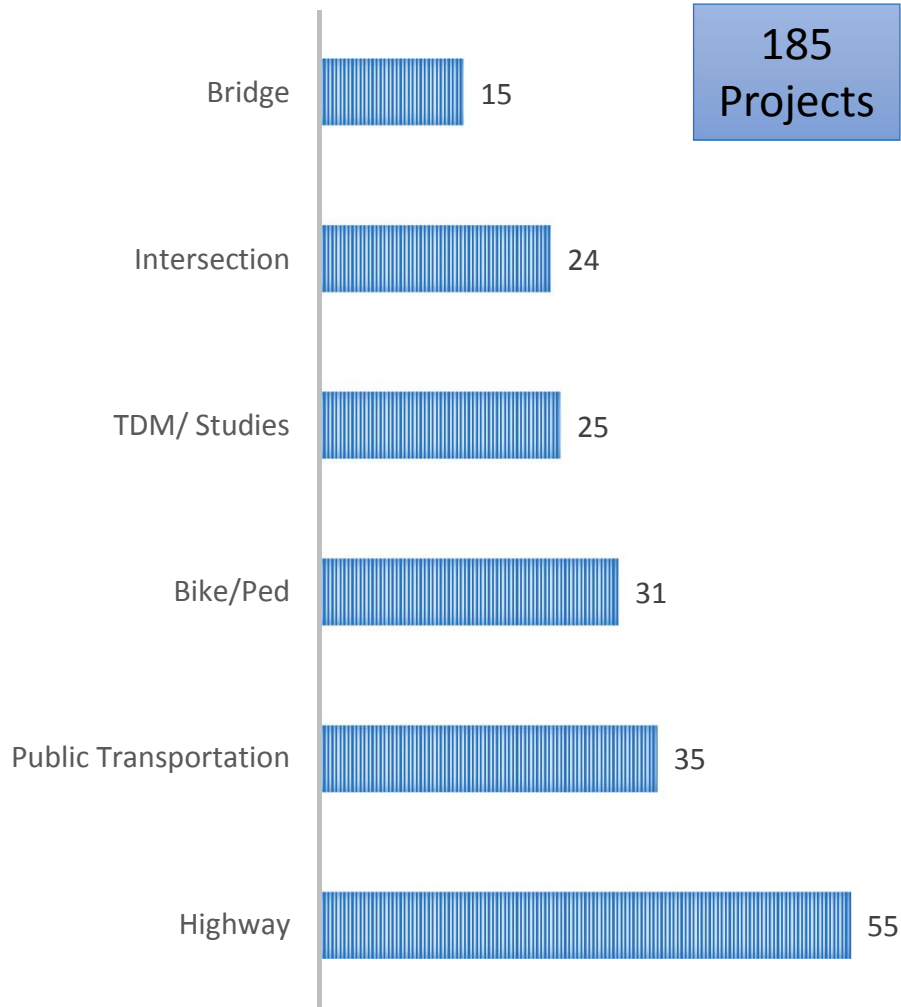
- TAC Review and Recommendation – April 11, 2017

May 2017

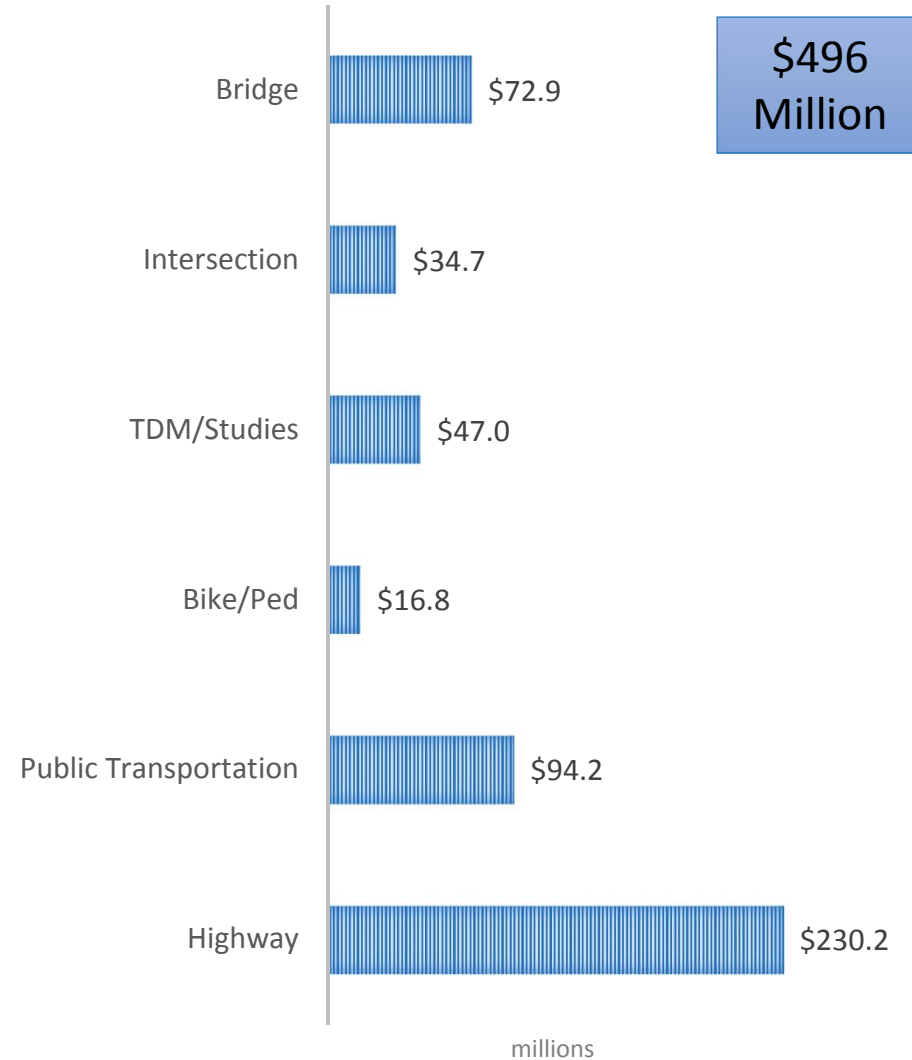
- **ACTION**: TPO approval of FY18 – FY21 TIP – May 4, 2017

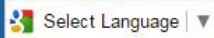

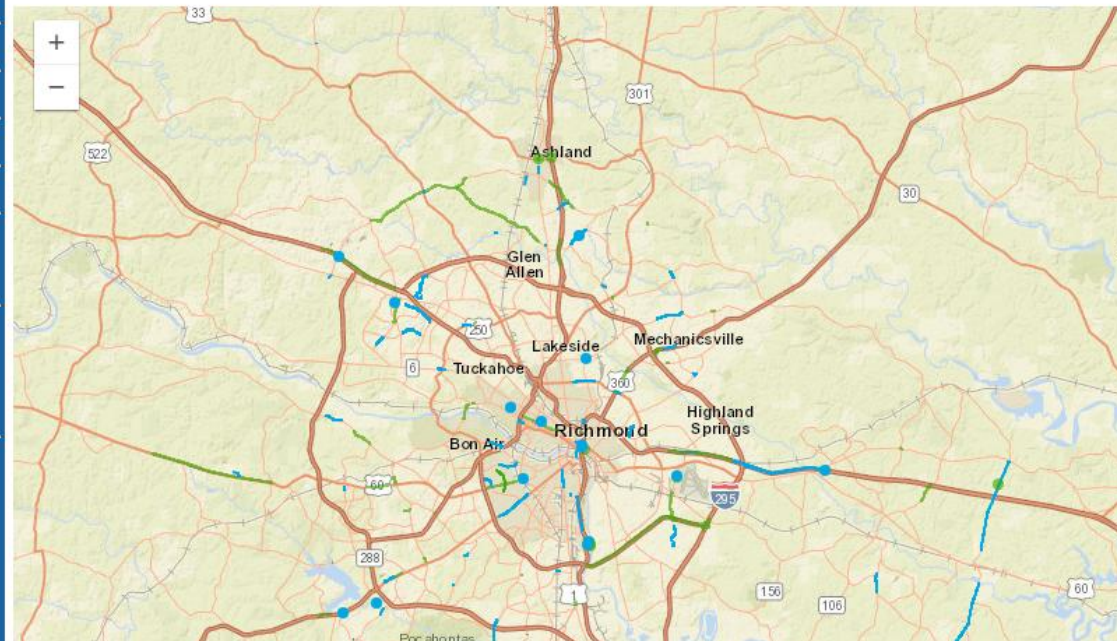
TIP Interactive Projects Map
